Within the past few weeks, the Wisconsin Arabian Horse Association has suffered the deaths of three members.

Debbie Scott was the wife of long-time WAHA member Bill Scott, who served several years as a Regional delegate from WAHA. During the past few years of their courtship and marriage, Debbie also became active in WAHA and devoted several hours a year to working at WAHA events. She was one of the first to receive paybacks from the new WAHA Volunteer Rewards program. Debbie died Christmas day 2008 after a long battle with cancer.
