

Effective December 1, 2010 **Current Rule**

You may have a new Select Rider status for the 2011 show season. **People who were not Select riders in 2009 based on a top 5 won in a Select Rider class would be Select until they win TWO CHAMPIONSHIPS in a Select Regional class.**

AR113 Abbreviations of Class Specifications. 2011 Show Season

Classes are open to rider/driver/handler who has not won any of the following:

(1) One (1) AHA Regional Top Five or higher in that particular performance section in which they are shown. As an example, Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, Country English Pleasure and English Pleasure are each separate performance sections.

(2) One (1) AHA National Top Ten or higher in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

(3) Two (2) AHA Regional Champion Awards in a Select class in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

(4) Two (2) AHA National Top Ten or higher awards in a Select class in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

Effective December 1, 2011 **2012 Rule**

This means that you may have a new Select Rider status for the 2012 show season.

- **No placings at Regionals in ANY class affect your Select status at the National level.**
- **National and Regional Classes with 2 or less entries will not affect Select status.**
- **National placings continue to affect your Select status at Regionals but some changes in the numbers.**
- **More placings from non-Select Regional classes are allowed before your Select status is affected.**

AR113 Abbreviations of Class Specifications. **2012 Show Season**

Select National Championship classes are open to competitors that have not won any of the following:

- (1) One (1) AHA National Champion, Reserve Champion or Top Ten; in that particular section in which they are shown. As an example Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, Country English Pleasure, English 26 Pleasure and Breeding/In-Hand are each separate sections.
- (2) One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion in a Select class in that particular section in which they are shown.
- (3) Three (3) AHA National Top Ten in a Select class in that particular section in which they are shown.

Select Regional Championship classes are open to a rider/driver/handler that has not won any of the following:

- (1) One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion or Top Ten in that particular section in which they are shown.
- (2) One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion in a Select class in that particular section in which they are shown.
- (3) **Three (3) AHA National Top Tens in a Select class** in that particular section in which they are shown.

- (4) **One (1) AHA Regional Champion, Reserve Champion or three (3) Top Fives** in that particular section in which they are shown.
- (5) Two (2) AHA Regional Champion in a Select Class in that particular section in which they are shown.

National and Regional Classes with 2 or less entries will not affect Select rider status.
